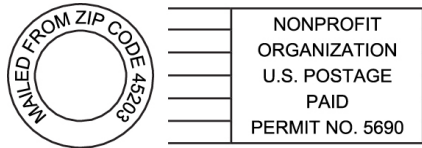

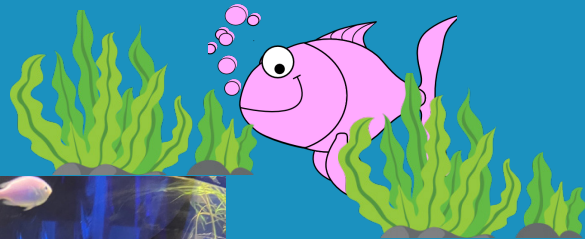

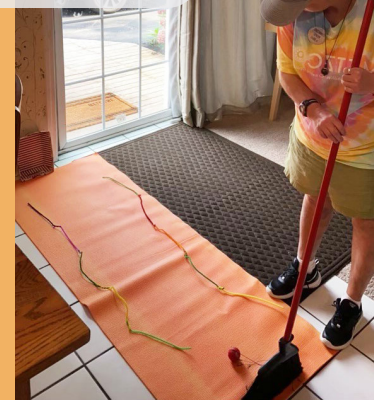
☀️ SUMMER BUCKET LISTS ☀️
